Cyber Safety for Young People

Tips for using social media

Anything posted online can be shared, copied and/or manipulated and may be there forever. You may not be able to control what people do with what you post. Use the following tips to try and avoid this:

- Disable geo-tagging of photos and avoid 'checking in' at locations.
- Check privacy settings to ensure that not everyone can see what you post.
- Avoid posting any personal information where practical.
- If you see anything that is offensive or you are uncomfortable with, make sure to discuss this with someone you trust and report it.
- Always read user agreements and privacy policies. Some organisations may sell your personal information to third parties or use it for marketing purposes.
- Never retaliate or respond to any form of cyber bullying or unwanted contact, and ensure you keep any evidence.
- Never click on suspicious links no matter who they are from.
- Be wary of contacts online as not everyone is who they say they are.
- Never meet someone face to face who you have only chatted with online.

Tips for staying safe and secure online

To help keep you safe online:

- Ensure all software is up to date and correctly configured.
- Use a reputable anti-virus product and ensure it is set to regularly update and automatically scan.
- Check and configure security and privacy settings on all sites and devices, and think about your online presence and the information that you share.
- Be wary of unsolicited phone calls and emails.
- Back up data regularly onto a different device to prevent data loss.
- Use strong passwords and make sure that every account has a different password.
- Always use legitimate software from a reputable source.
- If supported by your device, enable remote tracking and remote wiping functionalities in case the device is lost.
- Talk to your parents about the internet, and work with your parents in developing rules around use of the internet and devices.
- Ensure you know how to block and report people and content on the sites you use.
